Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Formella:

This letter is submitted on behalf of Robinette Legal Group, PLLC (“Robinette”) in accordance with N.H. Rev. Stat. § 359-C:20. Unauthorized actors accessed their information technology (IT) systems. The personal information of one (1) New Hampshire resident was affected.

In March 2026, Robinette detected a ransomware attack that affected its IT systems. Robinette immediately took protective actions to stop the unauthorized access, assessed the security of its systems, and launched an investigation with the assistance of leading cybersecurity specialists. The investigation indicates that personal information may have been accessed by an unauthorized party. The personal information that may have been subject to unauthorized access includes individuals’ name, Social Security number, and account number.

On April 21, 2026, Robinette began providing written notice of this incident to potentially affected individuals. The notice is in substantially the same form as **Exhibit A**.

Robinette has installed monitoring capabilities on its IT systems to detect suspicious activity and is implementing additional safeguards. Robinette offered potentially affected individuals one year of complimentary credit protection and monitoring services through CyberScout.

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Notice of Data Incident

Dear [REDACTED]:

Robinette Legal Group, PLLC (“Robinette” or “we”) is writing to inform you about a recent cybersecurity incident that may have impacted some of your personal information. The security of your information is important to us, and we take the trust you place in us very seriously. We wanted to advise you about the incident and offer resources you may find helpful.

What Happened? In March 2026, we detected unauthorized activity in our IT systems. We immediately took protective actions to stop the access and launched an investigation with the assistance of leading cybersecurity experts. The investigation found that some of your personal information may have been accessed by an unauthorized party. While we have no evidence that any of your information was misused in any manner, we are taking appropriate precautionary measures to ensure your financial security and help alleviate concerns you may have.

What Personal Information May Be Involved? The affected personal information may have included your name, Social Security number, account number, medical information, and health insurance information.

What We Are Doing. We took immediate protective actions to contain the activity and retained industry-leading cybersecurity experts to support our investigation and response actions. It is our priority to continue to evaluate and deploy the level of robust security protocols, continuous monitoring, and staff training needed to prevent and defend against sophisticated cybersecurity threats.

What You Can Do. Because our investigation indicated that some of your personal information may have been affected, we are offering access to Single Bureau Credit Monitoring/Single Bureau Credit Report/Single Bureau Credit Score at no charge. These services provide alerts when your credit information changes for twelve (12) months from the date of enrollment. These notifications are sent the same day that changes are made. We are also offering proactive fraud assistance to answer questions or in the event someone attempts to use your information without authorization. These services will be provided by Cyberscout, a TransUnion company specializing in fraud assistance and remediation services.

To enroll in Credit Monitoring services at no charge, please log on to <https://bfs.cyberscout.com/activate> and follow the instructions provided. When prompted please provide the following unique code to receive services: [REDACTED]. You must enroll within 90 days from the date of this letter. The enrollment requires an internet connection and e-mail account and may not be available to minors under 18. Please note that when signing up for monitoring services, you may be asked to verify personal information to confirm your identity.

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For More Information. We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this incident may cause you. If you have any questions regarding this matter or the services available to you, we are available to assist you for 90 days from the date of this letter. You can reach us Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, excluding holidays, by calling our office at (304) 594-1800.
