NOTICE OF DATA BREACH

We are writing to let you know that we recently became aware of a data breach involving a Fishbrain system. Upon investigating the breach, we determined that an unauthorized person accessed personal information about you, including information associated with your Fishbrain login credentials. If you use the password associated with your Fishbrain account for any other online account, we strongly recommend that you change the password for that account as soon as possible. We have separately reset affected users' passwords and terminated their active sessions on Fishbrain as a precaution.

WHAT HAPPENED?

On August 19, 2026, we discovered that an unauthorized person accessed an environment used by Fishbrain to host user data, and we immediately commenced a forensic investigation. On August 24, 2026, Fishbrain determined that the unauthorized person accessed information associated with certain users' login credentials, among other things. Our investigation indicates that the unauthorized access occurred as early as July 30, 2026.

WHAT INFORMATION WAS INVOLVED?

The personal information involved included your first and last name, email address, telephone number, Fishbrain username, country information, password hash, corresponding salt, and date of birth. Fishbrain passwords were not stored in plaintext; however, Fishbrain has determined that the compromised password hashes for some users may be susceptible to being decoded.

WHAT WE ARE DOING

We have patched the vulnerability, restricted access to the affected environment, and are continuing to investigate the incident. As an added security measure, we have reset passwords for affected accounts. You will be required to create a new password the next time you log in to Fishbrain. We are also enhancing our security protocols, conducting a broader review of our data security measures, and monitoring our systems to help protect against future unauthorized access.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

If you use your Fishbrain password for any other online accounts, you should promptly update those passwords and any associated security questions or answers. You should also take other appropriate steps to protect any online accounts that use the same username or email address and password combination. We recommend using a strong, unique password for each of your accounts.

We also encourage you to remain vigilant for suspicious emails or other communications that appear to come from Fishbrain. Please remember that we will never contact you to request your password or other sensitive account information.
