Re: Cybersecurity Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

The Idaho State Insurance Fund ("SIF") is writing to notify your office of a cybersecurity incident.

We have completed an investigation of suspicious activity associated with a SIF web portal. Upon learning of the activity, we immediately took steps to secure the portal. The investigation determined that an unauthorized and unknown person accessed the portal between August 9, 2026, and August 11, 2026. As part of the investigation, we determined that the name, address, and Social Security numbers of 2 Idaho residents were accessed without authorization.

On August 14, 2026, we mailed notification letters to the Idaho residents via United States First-Class mail. We offered the residents one year of complimentary credit monitoring, fraud consultation and identity theft restoration services through Epiq. We also provided a telephone number to the Idaho residents that they can call with any questions.
